

# 50th Anniversary Special

### Sunday 12th May 2019

Bookings are invited for the Special Train on Sunday 12th May from Kidderminster to Bridgnorth and back. This celebrates the 50th Anniversary of the Association on the Severn Valley Railway. We are the proud owners or custodians of a locomotive, seventeen passenger coaches, three 'brown' vehicles and one freight wagon all based on the Severn Valley Railway with all but two vehicles having been restored.

Departure from Kidderminster (SVR) will be at 11.10am. The train will proceed to Bewdley where it will halt for an hour allowing time to view progress on carriages 4786 and 5043, visit the Association shop and cut the birthday cake. We will then continue to Bridgnorth arriving at around 1.10pm. Up to 40 places for lunch at The George, located at the bottom of the Station Drive, have been reserved for those who may wish to dine there (see menu overleaf), however, it will also be possible to dine at the new Bridgnorth Station Restaurant.

There should be time for a works visit. Return from Bridgnorth is at 4.30pm arriving at Kidderminster around 5.30pm. We expect the service to be formed of six Great Western carriages hauled by an appropriate engine. We hope to have a raffle on board with the prize of a footplate ride on the return journey. Any surplus funds will go towards the restorations of carriage 4786 and Mogul 9303.
