Launch of the GWR Saloon Train

Bookings are invited for the Special Train on Wednesday 18th September from Kidderminster to Bridgnorth and back. This celebrates the launch into service of Collett Nondescript Saloon 9103 to join its fellow saloons 9055 and 9369 to form a unique set on the Severn Valley Railway. Built in 1929 at Swindon, it has proved to be the Association's longest ever restoration.

Departure from Kidderminster (SVR) will be at 11.05am. The train will proceed to Bridgnorth where, after a 45 minute turn round, we will head back to Highley arriving at 13.20 for a 1½ hour break. There will be time for a visit to The Engine House (entry included in ticket price) and a run past. If you want lunch, there will be separate sittings at 13.30 and 14.15 at The Flag and Whistle Food Stop at The Engine House. The train will halt at Bewdley for one hour for the official launch and viewing of 650 before it is due back at Kidderminster at 16.25. The service should be formed of Great Western (SVR) Association stock including 9103 and hauled by a Great Western engine (5643 requested). Any surplus funds made will go towards completion of carriage 650.

If you would like to join us the fare is only £12.50 with concessions (over 65 or under 16) at £10. Please complete the return slip below with cheques payable to GW (SVR) Association and an SAE. There will be a cutting of the ribbon by your Chairman at Kidderminster station on the return of the special.
